Site Visit Conditions

You are expected to carefully consider these Site Visit Conditions when deciding whether to attend a site visit.

- Attendance on a NFCI site visit by any person will be subject to these NFCI Site Visit Conditions. Corporate Members will be expected to have distributed a copy of these Conditions to persons attending a site visit via the corporate member whether guests or otherwise.
- The NFCI from time to time organises site visits for NFCI Members and guests. While these are intended to be an enjoyable highlight of our annual programme of events, there are potential health and safety dangers on any site no matter what phase the relevant development may be in, including when completed. The NFCI will expect all visitors to have carefully considered health and safety issues before attending any site.
- All visitors should prepare to undertake visits with the utmost care. Suitable clothing and footwear must be worn at all times and if specific safety wear is provided for the visit this must be worn according to any directions given.
- The NFCI does not accept responsibility for loss or damage to property of visitors, which should be regarded as entirely at the risk of the owner.
- A responsible adult must accompany visitors under the age of 16. Special access requirements (e.g. wheel chair access) should be notified to the NFCI in advance.
- The NFCI reserves the right to deny any visitor access to a site or to ask a visitor to leave a site for any reason whatsoever including where these Conditions have not been complied with.
- Where site owners or those responsible for a site provide specific health and safety guidance and information about a site, visitors are required to take proper account of this at all times.
- Unless the site owner or those responsible for a site grant consent, photography of any part of a site is not permitted in any circumstances.
