

A New Priscilla Bacon Hospice

Work to provide a new 24 bed specialist care facility for the Priscilla Bacon Hospice is now underway following the appointment of Morgan Sindall Construction as Main Contractor. The £12.5M, charity-funded, building will be located next to the Norfolk and Norwich Hospital and will replace the current building on Unthank Road, which was established over 40 years ago.

In this talk Rupert Kitchen, a Director and Chartered Architect at AJ100 listed Architectural practice LSI Architects, will share how the design for the hospice has developed throughout the project and discuss some of the key design features that will deliver a state-of-the-art building to support Priscilla Bacon Hospice as it delivers the specialist palliative and end of life care required in Norfolk and Waveney.
